Mayor Protem Greenwald welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present.

CM Newcomb moved to approve the agenda as presented. CM Welte voiced a second and the motion carried without dissent.

CM Newcomb moved to approve the minutes of the February 7, 2018 regular council meeting with the addition of changing the wording under PUBLIC COMMENT “purchase the equipment” to “tabling the discussion of the purchase until the March 7<sup>th</sup> council meeting after it was looked into further”. CM Welte offered a second and the measure passed unanimously.

**LAW ENFORCEMENT:** PC Moen reported 21 incidents this month. She continues to work on the DARE program. She also presented to council that she was almost finished with her Domestic Violence Classes she has been attending through Goshen County Task Force.

**LEGAL ITEMS:** TA Knudsen informed council that he is just waiting for the 2<sup>nd</sup> and final reading of Ordinance #336.

**ADMINISTRATION:** DCT Garner presented the financials for January 2018 and placed them on file; overall the financials look positive. DCT Garner also announced that nominations and filing applications for two council member positions and the Mayor position will be open from March 8<sup>th</sup> through March 30<sup>th</sup> and the filing fee is \$25.00.

**MAINTENANCE:** TS Haeffelin reported they had completed their quarterly nitrate samples. They have been doing snow removal and work in the shop. He also reported that they have attended a safety meeting and ATS Ochsner attended a WMPA board meeting.

ORDINANCES: CM Welte moved to approve Ordinance #336 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING CODE 3-1-1 THROUGH 3-1-7 OF THE TOWN OF LINGLE, WYOMING PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF NUISANCES WITHIN THE TOWN OF LINGLE, on the second reading. CM Newcomb input the second and it passed unanimously.

Mayor Protem Greenwald advised at 5:45 p.m. she was recessing the meeting so the council could go into an executive session.

Mayor Protem Greenwald reconvened the regular meeting at 6:13p.m. Delinquent utilities were discussed; no action taken.
