The Regular Meeting of the Lingle Town Council convened at 5:00pm, March 22, 2017 with Mayor Siglin leading the pledge of allegiance. Upon roll call, the following were present, constituting a quorum:

Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present.

CM Newcomb moved to approve the agenda with the addition of Raymond & Della Watson under Public Comment. CM Welte voiced a second and the motion carried without dissent.

CM Welte moved to approve the minutes of the March 8, 2017 regular council meeting as published. CM Greenwald offered a second and the measure passed unanimously.

Raymond & Della Watson were in attendance seeking approval to have their chickens for another year. There have not been any complaints or issues raised over the chickens, and the Council by consensus agreed to maintain this program for another year. They also raised the issue of the ditch that leaks into the alley behind their home, causing puddles and a good breeding ground for mosquitos. TS Haeffelin will look into the ditch issue and see what can be done to fix this.

Mayor Siglin reported the Fireman's Ball will be held Saturday, March 25th and encouraged all to attend.

Mayor Siglin reported PM Hill will be holding interviews for lifeguards applicants this week.

TA Knudsen announced the date of March 29th has been set for Small Claims Court for highly delinquent individuals. He will also be moving forward on a lien on 600 Freimuth for snow removal and clean up.

CT Sussex presented the financial report for January 2017 and placed it on file for reference. She also informed Council the Wyoming Business Council Grant was pulled for this quarter and will be submitted for the next quarter, as WBC is concerned that we still need to find more funding, which means we aren't project ready. A grant has been submitted to the Railroad in the amount of \$500K for the Legion/Community Center. The Town will also be looking into a loan from USDA for the remainder of the funds needed for the Legion/Community Center. Council also approved multiple other items from CT Sussex: 1) The Town will be sending DCT Garner to Wyo Municipal Court Assoc in May for training; 2) The official voting delegate for

WAM will be Michele Sussex; 3) The official voting delegate for Wyo Assoc of Rural Water Systems will be Jeremy Ochsner and; 4) DCT Garner will be added to the town bank account as an official signer. She also informed Council budget meetings have been set for April 12th and May 24th.

TS Haeffelin reported to Council he has been working hard on the volleyball courts as the group has received the second half of their grant for the volleyball courts.

Mayor Siglin led a discussion concerning Ordinance 195, 4-4-1984 (Code 4-2-1-1: Concealed Weapons.) TA Knudsen and Council will review Ordinance 195 and discuss at a later date.

Mayor Siglin announced a couple of town residents would like to put in a walking path/recreational trail in Town. The Mayor pointed out the obstacles they would encounter and encouraged them to form and group to organize and plan this project.

CM Welte & CT Sussex attended Wyoming Community Gas Forum and the Choice Gas Program will be April 7th through April 27th.

CM Newcomb noticed an error in the Torrington Telegram. The Recreation Dept announced in the newspaper that Lingle received grant funds for the volleyball courts, when it should have been the Lingle Volleyball Group receiving the funds. Council unanimously decided the Town would like to have a correction printed.

The Mayor advised at 5:41pm he was recessing the regular meeting so Council could go into an executive session concerning litigation and personnel issues. No action taken.

The Mayor reconvened the regular meeting at 5:48pm.

Mayor Siglin adjourned the meeting at 5:49pm.
