Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present.

CM Welte moved to approve the agenda as presented. CM Asa voiced a second and the motion carried without dissent.

CM Asa moved to approve the minutes of the February 22, 2017 regular council meeting as published. CM Welte offered a second and the measure passed unanimously.

CM Greenwald moved to pay February 2017 bills in the amount of \$84,357. CM Asa offered a second and the measure passed unanimously.

PC Moen reported that in the last two weeks there have been twenty (20) incidents.

LVFD FC Bangerter reported that in the month of February there were three (3) fires and one (1) ambulance call. He also stated that as of now there have been no applications for an EMT or Volunteer Fire Fighter turned in; however they still plan to continue with the EMT class. Lastly, he reported that there will be a Fireman's Ball held on the 25th of March.

TA Knudsen reported that he is currently working on small claim legalities.

DCT Garner informed Council of a slight change in the bill listing due to a returned check. At this time CM Greenwald asked her about the pool applications; DCT Garner reported that there have been three (3) returned and that there are four (4) still out.

TS Haeffelin reported to Council that he has left five messages with Verizon regarding the cell tower; as of now none of these calls have been returned. At this time CM Welte thanked TS Haeffelin for keeping up with snow removal.

Mayor Siglin led a discussion about an email that he received from Torrington Mayor Mike Varney pertaining to a four lane highway from Morrill Nebraska to Lingle. Mayor Siglin also discussed a letter from

LFL North Platte Valley South Goshen Conservation Districts, regarding a donation and mentioned that we donate to them every year.

CM Welte reported to the council that he has mention to Mayor Siglin and CT Sussex about applying to Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railway for donations to help fund the remodel of the Legion building.

Mayor Siglin reported to the council how his meeting on the 2nd of March, with Governor Mead regarding HB0137, went.

Mayor Siglin adjourned the meeting at 5:21 pm.
