Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present.

CM Greenwald moved to approve the agenda as presented. CM Newcomb voiced a second and the motion carried without dissent.

CM Welte moved to approve the minutes of the July 5, 2017 regular council meeting as published. CM Newcomb offered a second and the measure passed unanimously.

**LAW ENFORCEMENT:** PC Moen reported forty six (46) incidents; which include four (4) public assist, thirty nine (39) traffic, one (1) motor vehicle accident, one (1) animal at large and one (1) vandalism. She will be going to the range this month. She attended the eclipse meeting for updates.

**ADMINISTRATION:** CT Sussex presented the financial report for May 2017 and placed it on file for reference. She reported Legion building samples were taken to test for asbestos; they should be complete soon. She also reported multiple requests from individuals requesting information about parking and dining in Lingle for the eclipse. She reported WYDOT and the RR inspected the site where the silent crossing will be installed. A random headstone was found in the Cemetery; authorities have been notified to locate where it should be placed.

**MAINTENANCE:** TS Haeffelin reported they have poured fourteen (14) yards of concrete on Reid Street and fixed multiple street cracks. They also removed a large branch that fell on lines from a recent storm. He also reported their department has been mowing and have been working on the sprinkler system in the park.

**APPOINTMENTS:** CM Greenwald moved to re-appoint Johanna Abernathy as the Town of Lingle Lodging Tourist Board Representative. CM Asa offered a second and the motion carried without dissent.

**COUNCIL ITEMS:** CM Newcomb informed Council she will be having food vendors in the building she rents on Main Street for the solar eclipse.

The Mayor advised at 5:35pm he was recessing the regular meeting so Council could go into executive session.

Mayor Siglin reconvened the regular meeting at 6:05pm. Delinquent utility accounts were discussed and what action will be taken.

Mayor Siglin adjourned the meeting at 6:07pm.
