CM Newcomb moved to approve the agenda as presented. CM Greenwald voiced a second and the motion carried without dissent.

CM Welte moved to approve the minutes of the September 6, 2017 regular council meeting. CM Newcomb offered a second and the measure passed unanimously.

LVFD: S/T Hofer reported a power line down incident in the 700 block of Freimuth.

POOL: PM Hill announced they had a very good year at the Lingle Pool. Next year will be the 50th Anniversary of the Lingle Pool and she is planning some celebratory events. She is in the process of getting an estimate for a new projector for Movie in the Park Night.

ADMINISTRATION: CT Sussex presented the financial report for July 2017 and placed it on file for reference. She also reported she is working on the delinquent utility accounts and is making progress in collecting them. She thanked the Council for allowing her and DC/T Garner to attend the WAMCAT Institute; she learned of a few areas where Lingle can improve and move to be in full compliance with statues and regulations. She also learned some new regulations that are coming in the future.

MAINTENANCE: ATS Ochsner reported a water sample has been turned in. He attended an electrical school in Lusk recently. He also reported responding to the power line down; he was able to quickly correct everything with the help of Wyrulec; he offered a large thank you to Wyrulec for their assistance.

COUNCIL ITEMS: CM Asa attended the Blue Star Memorial dedication ceremony and would like to see an American and Wyoming flag raised at that location. CM Newcomb will present this request to the Lions Club.

CM Greenwald approached Goshen County Economic Development to participate in the Lingle 100th Anniversary celebration; they will meet with Lingle to discuss planning. CM Greenwald also discussed involving the Lodging Tax Board on planning for the celebration. CM Welte announced he will attend the Wyoming Community Gas meeting on September 28th.
