Dumpster Do's & Don'ts

The following items **CANNOT** be placed in the **Brown TDS Trash Containers:**



Ashes, Tires, Sod

Wire or Cable

Metal, Yard Waste

Batteries, Rock

Wire Fencing, Iron

Appliances of any type. Concrete/Cement

Air Conditioners or anything with refrigerant

Dead animals or parts of animals

E-waste - Computers, computer monitors, keyboards, etc.

Green TDS Trash Containers:

Only the following items are allowed:

Grass Clippings, Flowers

Garden/Yard Waste , Weeds

Metal Items - Contact us and we will collect the metal for recycling.

Refrigerator/Air Conditioners - The Freon **MUST** be pumped out.
