The Regular Meeting of the Lingle Town Council convened at 5:00pm, October 18, 2017 with Mayor Siglin leading the pledge of allegiance. Upon roll call, the following were present, constituting a quorum:

Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present.

CM Newcomb moved to approve the agenda as presented. CM Greenwald voiced a second and the motion carried without dissent.

CM Newcomb moved to approve the minutes of the October 4, 2017 regular council meeting. CM Greenwald offered a second and the measure passed unanimously.

LEGAL ITEMS: TA Knudsen reported he had looked over the Homeland Security Grant and signed it.

ADMINISTRATION: CT Sussex presented the financial report for August and September 2017 and placed them on file for reference. She also announced that we received \$2,000 from Black Hills Energy as part of a grant for the Community Center Building. The Town is eligible to apply for more money from Black Hills Energy after January 2018 for the Community Center Building. She announced that our Homeland Security Grant has been approved for fencing; S. Kirchhefer brought over the paperwork for the grant to obtain the Mayor's signature and CT Sussex attestation. S. Kirchhefer will submit the final paperwork and all that remains is the final approval on the EHP (Environmental Historical Preservation). Council agreed by unanimous decision that the carpet at the Senior Center and Town Hall should be cleaned, which will be done after November 1st. CT Sussex was also asked to look into what it would cost for the Town to accept credit cards for payments. She also presented the Fall Newsletter for approval, which was unanimously approved with a few minor changes.

MAINTENANCE: ATS Ochsner reported training for the RR Silent Crossing is complete. There is a repair that is needed on the silent crossing and the paperwork has been submitted; WYDOT has said the turn on date for the silent crossing will be October 26th. Maintenance has winterized the pool, the park and the cemetery. They will be doing some tree trimming in the near future so as to keep the power lines clear.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: Mayor Siglin announced to Department Heads that they should have their goals for this fiscal year complete for the next Council Meeting on November 8th.

NEW BUSINESS: Mayor Siglin announced Region I meeting will be held in Torrington on October 25th at 5:00 and encouraged all Council Members to attend. Mayor Siglin also announced that Lingle has purchased a table at the Goshen County Economic Development Annual Meeting on October 27th and encouraged all Council members to attend. Mayor Siglin then asked Council to cancel the November 22nd Council Meeting, as it is the eve before Thanksgiving and Council unanimously agreed; provided that if any issues were to come up, Council could call a meeting during that week sometime.

COUNCIL ITEMS: CM Newcomb announced that the Lions Club would like to erect a flag at the Blue Star Memorial. They asked the Town if electricity could be hooked up to the light. After reviewing the request it was decided that it would be more economical to have solar lighting for the flag pole.

Mayor Siglin adjourned the meeting at 5:40pm
