Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present.

CM Welte moved to approve the agenda as presented. CM Newcomb voiced a second and the motion carried without dissent.

CM Newcomb moved to approve the minutes of the September 20, 2017 regular council meeting. CM Asa offered a second and the measure passed unanimously.

CM Welte moved to pay the September 2017 bills in the amount of \$138,853.84. CM Newcomb offered a second and the measure passed unanimously.

LEGAL ITEMS: TA Knudsen reported two (2) legal hearings for collecting delinquent utilities went well; judgements were received and funds will be collected.

ADMINISTRATION: CT Sussex announced the WAM-JPIC meeting was informative on upcoming federal insurance rates. She also reported the final paperwork has been submitted for the RR Silent Crossing. She will also be looking at getting the carpet in Town Hall and the Senior Center cleaned soon.

MAINTENANCE: TS Haeffelin reported training will be coming up for the RR Silent Crossing. They have been winterizing the pool and the park. New doors have been completely installed in the park bathrooms. Water samples were submitted, and all the results were good. They also fixed a primary meter connection at the school; they will be cleaning up the chip seal real soon.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: Council reviewed Ordinance #211 concerning delinquent utility accounts; they unanimously agreed the ordinance must be strictly followed.

NEW BUSINESS: Mayor Siglin announced Region I meeting will be held in Torrington on October 25th at 5:00 and encouraged all Council Members to attend. Mayor Siglin also asked Council to consider a partial tuition reimbursement program; they declined the consideration at this time. Mayor Siglin also presented to

Council to purchase some high quality used desks for Town Hall as the current ones are broken and worn out;
Council approved of the new desks by unanimous decision.
