Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present. Mayor Siglin called for approval of the agenda with addition of Tom Bruce for Public Comment and an Executive Session. CM Welte moved to approve the agenda with the additions. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Siglin called for approval of the minutes of the November 6, 2019 regular council meeting. CM Edwardson moved to approve the minutes as presented. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

LEGAL ITEMS: TA Barnes discussed the Reau De-annexation and trial held in municipal court; the InnTech agreement is being finalized.

ADMINISTRATION: C Reyes reported that draw down #8 to the Wyoming Business Council has been completed and that daily operation of the Town Office is business as usual.

MAINTENANCE: TS Haeffelin reported that Visionary is interested in increasing their presence in Lingle TA Barnes will review the Pole Agreement currently in place with them; town maintenance is ongoing.

COUNCIL ITEMS: Council discussed equipment for the new Community Center and agreed to have a workshop to review furniture, fixtures and equipment for the Community Center on November 26, 2019 at 10 am. at the Town Office. Mayor Siglin discussed information concerning the Governors report for the upcoming biennium.
