Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present. Mayor Siglin called for approval of the agenda. CM Asa moved to approve the agenda as presented. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Linda Cockett, Director of the Goshen County Senior Center, addressed the Council on the renewal of the Senior Center lease contract. The contract will renew with no changes from the previous edition.

POLICE ITEMS: PC Andrews reported 9 incidents since the last Council meeting; will complete an intox training.

ADMINISTRATION: C Reyes reported the final documents for the Town's F-66 filing have been submitted; the annual LIEAP report was submitted; the fully executed Homeland Security grant for the generator has been received; and that Draw Down #8 for the Community Center will be done shortly.

MAINTENANCE: TS Haeffelin reported the well computers are now operating correctly; the radar trailer underwent repairs and that basic town maintenance is ongoing.

COUNCIL ITEMS: Mayor Siglin informed the Council that construction on the Community Center is on schedule; CM Asa moved to approve additional concrete work to the rear parking lot of the Community Center. CM Welte voiced the second and the motion passed unanimously.
