The Regular Meeting of the Lingle Town Council convened at 5:03pm, November 8, 2017 with Mayor Siglin leading the pledge of allegiance. Upon roll call, the following were present, constituting a quorum:

Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present.

CM Newcomb moved to approve the agenda as presented. CM Welte voiced a second and the motion carried without dissent.

CM Newcomb moved to approve the minutes of the October 18, 2017 regular council meeting. CM Greenwald offered a second and the measure passed unanimously.

CM Newcomb moved to pay the October 2017 bills in the amount of \$82,324.51. CM Welte offered a second and the measure passed unanimously.

**LAW ENFORCEMENT:** PC Moen will be on light duty until her final medical clearance.

**LVFD:** FC Bangerter announced they currently have three (3) individuals going through EMT class. Council asked if the current ambulance still meets their needs and FC Bangerter assured them that it does; they have no plans at this time to secure a new one.

**ADMINISTRATION:** CT Sussex announced the Lingle Guide will be raising their rates 3% for legal publications. She also presented what was learned from WAM in Saratoga. One item specifically was to meet with the same size individual communities around the state to see what procedures they have in place to run their pools/recreation centers, in an effort to improve on what Lingle already has in place. She has received no responses for volunteers to help with the 100-year anniversary for Lingle.

**MAINTENANCE:** TS Haeffelin reported they have gotten their equipment ready for the winter months. He also reported they have attended a safety meeting, clean all the alleys, swept up the chip seal on 3<sup>rd</sup> street and helped with moving in the new office furniture. In addition, TS Haeffelin also attended training in Casper on water/waste water management.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: After Council reviewed several options for accepting credit card payments; CM Newcomb moved to approve for Lingle to start accepting credit cards effective December 1, 2017 through PAYGOV.US, with a \$7.50 convenience fee for every payment made this way. CM Welte in the second and it passed unanimously. Council reviewed all the benefits that Goshen County Economic Development has brought to Lingle and they unanimously agreed Lingle should purchase a platinum membership to Economic Development.

NEW BUSINESS: CM Newcomb moved to approve Resolution #125 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF LINGLE TO ADOPT THE REGION 7 WYOMING MITIGATION PLAN. CM Welte input the second and it passed. CM Asa and CM Greenwald abstained.

The Mayor advised at 5:46 p.m. he was recessing the meeting so the council could go into an executive session to discuss delinquent utility accounts and personnel issues.

Mayor Siglin reconvened the regular meeting at 6:43 p.m. On the advice of legal counsel it was agreed to write-off delinquent utility accounts in the amount of \$1,652.21. No action on personnel issues was taken.

Mayor Siglin adjourned the regular meeting at 6:51 p.m.
