Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present. Mayor Siglin called for approval of the agenda with addition of Elle Franklin for Public Comment. CM Asa moved to approve the agenda with the addition. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Siglin called for approval of the minutes of the November 20, 2019 regular council meeting. CM Welte moved to approve the minutes as presented. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

BILLS FOR NOVEMBER 2019: CM Edwards moved to approve the bills in the amount of \$173,266.73. CM Asa voiced the second and the motion passed unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Elle Franklin, owner of the Corner Bar, expressed an interest in adjusting Sunday alcohol sales times. The Council will take it under consideration.

LVFD ITEMS: FC Bangerter reported three ambulance and two fire calls since the last council meeting; a possible Fireman's Ball to take place in March of 2020.

MAINTENANCE: TS Haeffelin reported that Christmas decorations are put up; snow removal went well; Town water samples all tested good and that town maintenance is ongoing.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: Following the workshop discussing the purchase of furniture, fixtures and equipment Mayor Siglin called for a motion to approve the purchases. CM Cook moved to approve the purchase of a PA System/recording system, tables, chairs, and desks for the new Community Center. CM Welte voiced the second and the motion passed unanimously.

COUNCIL ITEMS: CM Cook has asked the High School Shop to construct a podium for the new Community Center.
