The Regular Meeting of the Lingle Town Council convened at 7:00 PM December 7, 2022 with Mayor Unverzagt leading the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call, the following were present, constituting a quorum:

Mayor Unverzagt welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present. Mayor Unverzagt called for changes to the agenda. Being none, CM Cook moved to approve the agenda as presented. CM Wilhelm voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously. Mayor Unverzagt called for approval of the minutes of the November 9, 2022 regular council meeting. CM Wilhelm moved to approve the minutes as presented. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

BILLS November 2022: CM Lambert moved to approve the bills in the amount of \$ 98,442.01. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

POLICE ITEMS: In her absence PC Andrews conveyed the following information to C/T Reyes to report to the Council: PC Andrews attended the Christmas Pageant at the school; She attended District Court as a witness in Torrington the past two days; Will begin a juvenile case investigation early next week.

LVFD: FC Bangerter reported: Eleven ambulance calls for the previous month and no fire calls;

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS: C/T Reyes reported: The Municipal and Industrial water report for 2022 was submitted and received by the Wyoming State Engineer's Office; Two events are scheduled to take place in the Community Center December 19th and 20th. The Town and Maintenance offices will be closed December 23rd and 26th for Christmas.

MAINTENANCE ITEMS: TS Haeffelin reported: The new larger "Compression Brakes" signs have been put up; A boring company will begin activities on Main Street Friday December 9, 2022 for the installation of optic fiber casing; Discussion of the Senior Center restroom upgrade took place and T/S Haeffelin reported no bids have been received to date.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: Discussion of the Town Christmas Party took place and it was decided that the event will take place in the Lingle Community Center at 6:00 P.M. December 21, 2022. Anyone interested can complete the signup sheet.

NEW BUSINESS: Following discussion the Council approved by consensus to conduct the Annual Community Christmas Lighting Contest. Council Members will drive through Lingle and select 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners. The winners will receive a utility bill credit in the following amounts: 1st - \$100, 2nd - \$75 and 3rd - \$50. The Council will have the contest winners selected by December 21, 2022; Following discussion CM Wilhelm moved to approve a donation in the amount of \$500 to the Lingle-Fort Laramie Conservation District for the Hazard Waste Day Collection. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion passed with 4 ayes and 1 nay; Following discussion CM Cook moved to approve Mayor Unverzagt sign a Letter of Engagement with Lenhart, Mason and Assoc., LLC for agreed upon procedures for the Town of Lingle. CM Foster voiced the second and the motion passed unanimously.

COUNCIL ITEMS: CM Wilhelm discussed her attendance of the Goshen County Library Retreat. She mentioned to the Council Members that she has a library survey should anyone like to complete it; CM Cook raised the subject of solar panels. A discussion between the Council and T/S Haeffelin took place. With no further business to conduct Mayor Unverzagt adjourned the meeting at 7:38 PM.
