ORDINANCES: SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE #350 AN ORDINANCE

ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS CONCERNING TOBACCO/NICOTINE SALES, PURCHASES AND USAGE BY AND TO PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF TWENTY-ONE (21) YEARS; PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS.

CM Welte moved to approve the second reading of Ordinance #350. CM Lambert voiced the second and the motion passed unanimously.

SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE #351 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING ARTICLE 4, PARAGRAPH 1-405 OF ORDINANCE NO. 195 OF THE TOWN OF LINGLE, WYOMING MUNICIPAL CODE.

CM Cook moved to approve the second reading of Ordinance #351. CM Joe Welte voiced the second and the motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS: Following discussion of the updated contract and authorization forms with WYRULEC Council Members agreed by consensus to appoint Town Supervisor Larry Haeffelin and Treasurer Nakisha Garner as authorized signatories and contacts for the account.
