Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present. Mayor Siglin welcomed Tom Milstead reporter for the Lingle Guide/Torrington Telegram to the meeting. Mayor Siglin called for approval of the agenda. CM Welte moved to approve the agenda. CM Edwardson voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Siglin called for approval of the minutes of the January 22, 2020 regular council meeting. CM Welte moved to approve the minutes as presented. CM Edwardson voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

BILLS FOR JANUARY 2020: CM Edwardson moved to approve the bills in the amount of \$303,122.58. CM Welte voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

FIRE DEPARTMENT: FC Bangerter reported: Four ambulance calls and one fire call since the last Council meeting; He is working on a FEMA grant for gear; the Fireman's Ball will take place 3/21/2020; the grant to be submitted to SLIB for a new ambulance is due 2/19/2020.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS: C Reyes reported: Draw down #11 will be submitted to the Wyoming Business Council for the Community Center; the 2019 Survey of Occupational Injuries and Illnesses was submitted 1/29/2020; the Town has received confirmation that the Community Center is now insured.

MAINTENANCE: TS Haeffelin reported: Snow removal is ongoing; the generator has been ordered and general maintenance to Town vehicles is ongoing.

NEW BUSINESS: An application for a 24-Hour Malt Beverage Permit was submitted by Mary Jones to be used in the Lingle Community Center February 29, 2020. CM Cook moved to approve the permit. CM Edwardson voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

ORDINANCES: THIRD READING OF ORDINANCE #344 AN ORDINANCE DE-ANNEXING FROM THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF LINGLE, WYOMING, REAL PROPERTY KNOWN AS A 1.22 ACRE PORTION OF TRACT 2, WALKERS FIRST ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF LINGLE.

CM Cook moved to approve the third reading of Ordinance #344. CM Edwardson voiced the second and the motion passed unanimously.

FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE #345 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING AND SETTING FORTH THE HOURS AND TIME LICENSED RETAIL LIQUOR DEALERS SHALL BE PERMITTED TO BE OPEN FOR BUSINESS AND THE TIME ALL PATRONS ARE TO BE REMOVED FROM THE BUSINESS PREMISES, ETC.; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 154 OF THE TOWN OF LINGLE.

CM Welte moved to approve the first reading of Ordinance #345. CM Edwardson voiced the second and the motion passed unanimously.

COUNCIL ITEMS: Mayor Siglin reminded all meeting attendees of the Lingle Community Center Open house. The event is scheduled to take place from 4 P.M. to 7 P.M. with the ribbon cutting at 4:30 P.M. CM Cook suggested that blinds be installed on the Community Center Office door. C Reyes will contact ABC Blinds for a price quote.
