Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present. Mayor Siglin called for approval of the agenda. CM Lambert moved to approve the agenda as presented. CM Welte voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously. Mayor Siglin called for approval of the minutes of the January 5, 2022 regular council meeting. CM Welte moved to approve the minutes as presented. CM Edwardson voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

BILLS FOR JANUARY 2022: CM Edwardson moved to approve the Town bills in the amount of \$94,090.82. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

POLICE ITEMS: PC ANDREWS: Reported that her time has been distributed between school kids, dogs, disturbances and traffic.

POOL: PM HILL: Reported various issues with the pool: chlorine shortage, diving board replacement, and asked for a possible raise in wages for lifeguards.

LVFD: S/T Lambert: Reported five ambulance calls and one fire call since the last Council Meeting; the Fireman's Ball will take place March 5, 2022 from 9 PM to 1 AM.; the LVFD will have a team competing at the State Fire Convention in Lander, WY; S/T Lambert also informed Council that Ft. Laramie plans to shut down their ambulance service and that a meeting will take place for logistics.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS: C Reyes: Reported a Public Water System Survey Report was submitted to the Wyoming Water Development Office; The Consumer Confidence Report Questionnaire was submitted to Energy Laboratories; A Member Data Request form was submitted to the Wyoming Municipal Power Agency; The Town Office will be closed February 21<sup>st</sup> for Presidents Day.

MAINTENANCE ITEMS: TS HAEFFELIN: Annual maintenance will be performed on the municipal vehicles and that it is business as usual for the Maintenance Department.

**RESOLUTIONS: RESOLUTION #136: A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PROPOSITION FOR THE ONE PERCENT (1%) SPECIFIC PURPOSE EXCISE TAX IN GOSHEN COUNTY, WYOMING**

Mayor Siglin read the Resolution to all in attendance and explained the 6<sup>th</sup> penny tax. Following discussion of Resolution #136 by the Council CM Welte moved to accept Resolution #136. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion passed unanimously.

COUNCIL ITEMS: CM Cook announced that she will be attending a Goshen Economic Development Progress Program meeting on February 10, 2022 to review grant submissions; She also reminded all in attendance of the Main Street Beautification event to take place on March 21, 2022 at 8 AM.; Mayor Siglin informed all that the Wyoming Legislature is set to convene in Cheyenne on February 14, 2022; The Wyoming Association of Municipalities will meet in Cheyenne February 23-25 and that he will attend the event; He also reminded everyone that this is an election year and that the Town of Lingle will be accepting nominations and voting for two (2) Council Members and a Mayor. The election will take place in the Lingle Community Center on May 10, 2022; Mayor Siglin also discussed the annual budget and review of the budget will take place March-April 2022; He also informed all that two years ago a Dedication Ceremony was performed for the newly completed Lingle Community Center.

With no further business to conduct Mayor Siglin adjourned the meeting at 5:44 PM.
