Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present. Mayor Siglin called for approval of the agenda. CM Welte moved to approve the agenda as presented. CM Lambert voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously. Mayor Siglin called for approval of the minutes of the February 9, 2022 regular council meeting. CM Edwardson moved to approve the minutes as presented. CM Lambert voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

**BILLS FOR FEBRUARY 2022:** CM Edwardson moved to approve the Town bills in the amount of \$106,245.88. CM Welte voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

**LVFD:** S/T Lambert: Reported six ambulance calls and one fire call since the last Council Meeting; the Fireman’s Ball was postponed and rescheduled to take place March 19, 2022 from 9 PM to 1 AM.; S/T Lambert brought the new cot in the ambulance to demonstrate the capabilities and features of the new cot for the Council Members.

**ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS:** C Reyes reported: Work on the Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance continues; the Public Notice for the Town of Lingle Municipal Election has been published, two Council positions and one Mayor position are up for election. Applications can be picked up at the Town Office beginning at 7:00 AM March 11, 2022. The final day to apply for a Municipal Council position is March 31, 2022 at 4:00 PM. A \$25 non-refundable application fee must also be submitted with the application.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Replacement of a town Maintenance vehicle was discussed and by consensus the Council agreed to publish bids for replacement of the vehicle in the Lingle Guide. The Council also discussed replacement of the Town lawn mower. The Council agreed to have the lawn mower replaced. Pricing information will be gathered for the lawn mower replacement.

**COUNCIL ITEMS:** CM Edwardson addressed a question that was posed during the previous Council Meeting concerning “Contingency Funds.” CM Edwardson explained that the funds are in place in the event of an emergency incurred by the Town. Mayor Siglin addressed all in attendance and relayed that

the Direct Distribution Funds dispersed to Wyoming Municipalities that is in discussion at the Wyoming Legislature is currently in Conference.

With no further business to conduct Mayor Siglin adjourned the meeting at 5:17 PM.
