The Regular Meeting of the Lingle Town Council convened at 5:00 pm, April 4, 2018 with Mayor Siglin leading the pledge of allegiance. Upon roll call, the following were present, constituting a quorum:

Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present.

CM Newcomb moved to approve the agenda as presented. CM Asa voiced a second and the motion carried without dissent.

CM Newcomb moved to approve the minutes of the March 21, 2018 regular council meeting. CM Asa offered a second and the measure passed unanimously.

CM Newcomb moved to pay March bills in the amount \$90,873.84. CM Asa offered a second and the measure passed unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Decilla Watson mentioned to council that she would like to see a “Welcome to Lingle” sign as you enter town.

LAW ENFORCEMENT: PC Moen reported 30 incidents this month. She continues to work on the DARE program. She also presented to council that she will be attending the WASCOP conference this month and will be taking DARE kids to Elitches in May.

LVFD ITEMS: FC Bangerter announced they had three ambulance calls and one fire. He also presented to council that the town now has four EMTs. He reported that on April 10th they will be testing the tornado sirens between 10AM and 10:30AM.

POOL ITEMS: PM Hill reported that the time to apply for lifeguards has closed. She announced that the pool got the grant from the Rec Board and that new equipment for the pool is being ordered. She also told council that she is in the process of looking for a new trainer to train her lifeguards.

LEGAL ITEMS: TA Knudsen told council that there is nothing legally binding Weed & Pest to spray the town.

ADMINISTRATION: DCT Garner announced that she gave TA Knudsen the Vyve franchise contract for review. She also reported that the grant to GCEDC for the 100-yr. anniversary was submitted in the amount of \$27,000 and that the grant to USDA for a new law enforcement vehicle in the amount of \$33,000 was also submitted. She announced that the time to file for office has now closed and that two people filed for mayor and two for council member. DCT ended her discussion by informing the council that Barry Lee and MC Painting submitted estimates for the painting of the pool house and park bathrooms.

MAINTENANCE: TS Haeffelin reported that the town had a power outage over the weekend. He also announced that they have received all the parts for the new pump at the cemetery and that they will be working to replace it. He informed council that DEQ will be here April 10th to re-permit the dump and that ATS Ochsner will be attending classes this month. He announced that he will be planning a town power outage for the beginning of June so they can do some maintenance to the substation.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: Council by unanimous decision agreed to send out the donation letter for the Community Center.

NEW BUSINESS: CM Newcomb made a motion to designate CT Sussex as the WAM voting delegate. CM Asa voiced a second and the measure passed unanimously. CM Newcomb made a motion to designate ATS Ochsner as the WMPA voting Delegate. CM Asa offered a second and the measure passed unanimously.

COUNCIL ITEMS: CM Newcomb informed council that she has been in touch with a reporter for the Scottsbluff Herald and that he will be advertising any information about the 100-yr. Anniversary that she give him.

CM Greenwald couldn't make it but asked Mayor Siglin to discuss with council about flower pots and inform them that they will cost \$100 each.

Mayor Siglin announced that Goshen County Task Force wants to raffle off a Ford Thunderbird that was donated to them, at the park on the Saturday of our 100-yr. celebration.

Mayor Siglin adjourned the regular meeting at 5:47 pm.
