Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present.

CM Asa moved to approve the agenda with the addition of reading Resolution's #333 and #334. CM Welte voiced a second and the motion carried without dissent.

CM Welte moved to approve the minutes of the April 19, 2017 regular council meeting as published. CM Newcomb offered a second and the measure passed unanimously.

CM Welte moved to pay April 2017 bills in the amount of \$119,691.49. CM Newcomb offered a second and the measure passed unanimously.

PC Moen reported the Town's contract with Waggin Tails has expired, and they will be sending us a new contract for review.

PM Hill announced lifeguard training will begin May 15. The school has requested to hold an "end of school party/field day" at the Lingle pool, and by unanimous decision Council approved the request.

TA Knudsen presented a draft to update Lingle Code 4-2-1-1 for Concealed Weapons. Council will review the draft and move forward on this.

CT Sussex announced the choice gas selection period has ended with a rate of 48.3¢ per therm with Wyoming Community Gas.

TS Haeffelin reported the volleyball courts will be complete this week; however the horseshoe pits are still being worked on. They will be filling the pool next week.

CM Welte moved to approve Ordinance #333 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 5, SECTION 1-B TO INCREASE THE ELECTRIC RATES IN EFFECT FOR THE TOWN OF LINGLE, on first reading. CM Newcomb input the second and it passed unanimously.

CM Newcomb moved to approve Ordinance #334 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE TOWN OF LINGLE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1 JULY 2017 TO 30 JUNE 2018, on first reading. CM Asa input the second and it passed unanimously.

CM Newcomb reported on the recent Solar Eclipse meeting. The state of Wyoming is expected to have thousands of visitors from around the world for the event.

Mayor Siglin adjourned the meeting at 5:46pm.
