FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE #347 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE TOWN OF LINGLE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2020 TO JUNE 30, 2021.

CM Welte moved to approve the first reading of Ordinance #347. CM Edwardson voiced the second and the motion passed unanimously.
