Mayor Unverzagt welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present. Mayor Unverzagt asked if any of the attendees would like to be added to the Public Comment section of the Council Meeting and Bill Carr asked to be added to the Agenda. Mayor Unverzagt called for approval of the Agenda with the addition of Bill Carr to Public Comment. CM Cook moved to approve the Agenda with the addition of Mr. Carr to Public Comment. CM Wilhelm voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously. Mayor Unverzagt called for approval of the minutes of the June 8, 2022 regular council meeting. CM Lambert moved to approve the minutes as presented. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

**PUBLIC COMMENT:** Kurt Sittner, representative for Torrington Disposal Service addressed the Council concerning the fuel surcharge TDS charges the town for garbage collection. Council Members asked about the process to calculate the price that TDS charges for diesel fuel. Mr. Sittner replied that the morning that invoices are to be calculated pictures of diesel gas prices are taken at Maverick fuel pumps and that is the price used to calculate the fuel surcharge. Council Thanked Mr. Sittner for his explanation and service to the Town of Lingle. Steve Edwardson addressed the Council on the protocol regarding audience participation during a council regular meeting. Following discussion, CM Wilhelm moved to allow participation by the audience by first raising their hand to be recognized and given two minutes to present. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously. Charles Koozer voiced his concern with maintenance of weeds in the alley. Discussion took place and it was decided that TA Barnes would review ownership of the alley and report back to the Council. Bill Carr, representative for the Lingle Ft. Laramie Lions Club, informed the Council that the Lions Club was planning an event in the Whipple Park on August 10, 2022. He requested use of the park, the band shell and that the pool be open to the public for free including lifeguards. CM Cook moved to approve the use of the pool, band shell and pool/lifeguards. CM Foster voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

POLICE ITEMS: PC Andrews reported: She has been attending a training that will continue thru the end of week and has been dealing with domestic issues.

LEGAL ITEMS: TA Barnes reported: The town has two outstanding utility bills that are owed by non-residents. T Garner will initiate small claims court to recoup the funds; She informed that the Nuisance Ordinance is in the process of being reviewed.

POOL ITEMS: PM Hill reported: Pool attendance has increased since the decrease in admittance prices; Approximately sixty people attended the first movie in the park and all is well at the swimming pool.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS: C Reyes reported: The final distribution of Non-Entitlement Units or A.R P.A. Funds will be distributed to the Town of Lingle in the amount of \$39,641.07.

MAINTENANCE ITEMS: TS Haeffelin reported: The well casing was saved and repairs are completed the pump is in the process of being replaced; Divers will be in Lingle next week to inspect the town water tank.

ORDINANCES: Third reading of Ordinance #361 **AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE TOWN OF LINGLE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2022 TO JUNE 30, 2023.**

Following discussion CM Cook moved to approve the third reading of Ordinance #361. CM Lambert voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

Third reading of Ordinance #362 **AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 359 OF THE TOWN OF LINGLE SETTING RATES FOR FUEL SURCHARGE FOR ALL GARBAGE UTILITY CUSTOMERS.**

Following discussion CM Lambert moved to approve the third reading of Ordinance #362. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS: Employee Appointments: The Council voted by consensus to reappoint the following Town Employees: Police Chief Andrews, Clerk/Treasurer Reyes, Deputy Clerk/Treasurer Garner, Municipal Judge Patrick, Town Supervisor Haeffelin, Assistant Town Supervisor Ochsner and Town Attorney Barnes.

COUNCIL ITEMS: CM Lambert informed all attendees that anyone raising their voices during a Council Meeting will be removed from the meeting.

With no further business to conduct Mayor Unverzagt adjourned the meeting at 8:12 PM.
