The Regular Meeting of the Lingle Town Council convened at 5:00 PM June 23, 2021 with Mayor Siglin leading the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call, the following were present, constituting a quorum:

Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present. Mayor Siglin asked for additions to the agenda and being none called for approval of the agenda as presented. CM Welte moved to approve the agenda as presented. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Siglin called for approval of the minutes of the June 9, 2021 regular council meeting. CM Edwardson moved to approve the minutes as presented. CM Welte voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

LVFD: Mayor Siglin reported that the Fire Department has had very little activity and that it is unknown if a fire ban will be instituted during the Fourth of July weekend.

ADMINISTRATIVE: C Reyes reported: That other than every day business most of his time has been dedicated to updating ordinances.

MAINTENANCE: Mayor Siglin reported for TA Haeffelin: It has been business as usual for the Maintenance Department and Clean up Week is complete.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: Following discussion the Council requested that the Goshen County Library Foundation suggest dates for the ribbon cutting of the StoryWalk.

ORDINANCES: THIRD READING OF ORDINANCE #352 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE TOWN OF LINGLE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2021 TO JUNE 30, 2022.

Following the title reading of Ordinance #352 CM Cook moved to approve the third reading of Ordinance #352. CM Welte voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE #353 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING ORDINANCE 195 OF THE TOWN OF LINGLE, WYOMING PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF CERTAIN TRAFFIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE TOWN OF LINGLE.

Following the title reading of Ordinance #353 CM Welte moved to approve the second reading of Ordinance #353. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE #354 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 274 OF THE TOWN OF LINGLE, WYOMING MUNICIPAL CODE AND FEES.

Following the title reading of Ordinance #354 CM Welte moved to approve the second reading of Ordinance #354. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE #355 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND ADDING SECTION 8 OF ORDINANCE #109, ADDING FAILURE TO APPEAR FOR ARRAIGNMENTS AND TRIALS IN MUNICIPAL COURT.

Following the title reading of Ordinance #355 CM Welte moved to approve the second reading of Ordinance #355. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS: NOTICE OF HEARING BEFORE THE BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT LINGLE TOWN COUNCIL VARIANCE REQUEST – CATHY DAISS.

Following discussion between the Lingle Town Council on the Daiss Variance Request Mayor Siglin called for a motion. CM Edwardson moved to approve the Daiss Variance Request. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

NEWCOMB’S HEATING & COOLING SERVICE CONTRACT RENEWAL

Following discussion of the service contract renewal for Newcomb’s Heating and cooling CM Edwardson moved to approve the contract. CM Welte voiced the second and the motion passed unanimously.

SUMMER NEWSLETTER APPROVAL

The Council voted by consensus to approve the Summer Newsletter for the Town of Lingle.

COUNCIL ITEMS: Mayor Siglin discussed tentative ordinances No. 356 and No. 357 with the Council. The Mayor and Council discussed and agreed to table Ordinance No. 356 and put Ordinance No. 357 on the next agenda. Following discussion and the tabling of Ordinance No. 356 C Reyes requested that the Ordinance No. 357 be changed to No. 356 and Council agreed. The Town Council agreed to not receive a monthly salary for the next fiscal year; the Town office will be closed Thursday June 24th from 10:30 to 1:30 due to a municipal meeting with Wyoming Governor Gordon; the Town office will also be closed Friday July 23rd and the Pool will closed Thursday June 24th due to Lifeguard training. CM Cook brought up the subject of nuisance properties and how to handle them. Following discussion, the matter was tabled. With no further business to conduct Mayor Siglin adjourned the meeting at 5:42 PM.
