The Regular Meeting of the Lingle Town Council convened at 7:00 PM July 20, 2022 with Mayor Unverzagt leading the Pledge of Allegiance. Upon roll call, the following were present, constituting a quorum:

Mayor Unverzagt welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present. Mayor Unverzagt called for changes to the agenda. Being none, CM Wilhelm moved to approve the Agenda as presented. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously. Mayor Unverzagt called for approval of the minutes of the July 6, 2022 regular council meeting. CM Lambert moved to approve the minutes as presented. CM Wilhelm voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Lingle Volunteer Fire Department Secretary/Treasurer Tabitha Lambert informed the council that the Fire Department is planning a street dance August 20, 2022 from 8PM to 12AM. There will be no cover charge; only persons over 21 years of age will be permitted inside the barrier; The Corner Bar will be catering the event from inside the bar; LVFD members will be conducting security during the event. She requested a street closure for the duration of the street dance of 2nd street from Main Street to the Alley behind the Corner Bar. In addition, she requested an open container permit for the same time and area. Following discussion of the event CM Cook moved to approve the street closure from 8PM to 12AM and open container permit. CM Wilhelm voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously. Lingle Resident, Steve Edwardson informed all in attendance of the Town Hall Meeting featuring candidates seeking elected offices to take place in Torrington on July 21, 2022.

POLICE ITEMS: PC Andrews reported: The event at Whipple Park on July 16, 2022 went well with no incidents and all is good within the department.

LVFD: CM Lambert reported: LVFD has purchased back the old fire engine from Mike Varney; The Fire Department will be conducting a free will donation hamburger fry on August 10, 2022 in conjunction with the Lions Club event planned for the same day.

POOL ITEMS: PM Hill reported: The Splash Pool and Park Bash event went well July 16, 2022; There will be a movie in Whipple Park July 23, 2022 at 9PM along with a free swim session from

5PM to 8 PM sponsored by Shelly Duncan; The Lingle Pool will have limited hours due to staff shortages on August 21st and 22nd and closed August 28, 2022.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS: C/T Reyes reported the 2022-23 Budget Summary Sheet has been submitted to the Goshen County Assessor.

MAINTENANCE ITEMS: TS Haeffelin reported: Well #1 is operational and has passed all sample tests. Water production has increased due to the repairs and upgrades.

NEW BUSINESS: C/T Reyes presented to Council a Full-Service Copier Contract for approval. Following discussion and the age of the current copier C/T Reyes will research leasing a new copier and full-service contract. The results will be presented to the Council when received. CM Cook moved to table the approval of the Full-Service Copier Contract. CM Foster voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously. The Summer Newsletter was reviewed by the Council and CM Cook moved to approve the Summer Newsletter. CM Wilhelm voice the second and the motion carried unanimously.

COUNCIL ITEMS: CM Lambert informed attendees that the sandbags from the flood will be cleaned up in the near future; CM Wilhelm discussed the annual F-66 and Agreed Upon Procedures and Mayor Unverzagt has been in contact with Lenhart, Mason and Associates, LLC concerning these items.

With no further business to conduct Mayor Unverzagt adjourned the meeting at 7:42 PM.
