Mayor Unverzagt welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present. Mayor Unverzagt called for any updates to the agenda. Lennie Sandlian representing the Senior Center asked to be added to Public Comment. CM Wilhelm moved to approve the Agenda with the addition. CM Foster voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously. Mayor Unverzagt called for approval of the minutes of the August 3, 2022 regular council meeting. CM Lambert moved to approve the minutes as presented. CM Wilhelm voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

PUBLIC COMMENT: Lennie Sandlian, representing the Senior Center, addressed the Council concerning the restrooms in the Senior Center. She stated that the toilets need to be taller and that the door to the men's restroom is too narrow. She offered a suggestion to resolve the issues: the men's and women's restrooms be converted into a single unisex restroom that complies with ADA regulations along with a mop sink and drain. Discussion took place and CM Wilhelm stated that she would approach her church about remodeling the restroom. Linda Cockett, Senior Center Director, will attend the next council meeting and further discuss the situation.

POLICE ITEMS: PC Andrews reported: She is preparing for the LVFD Street Dance and the Swimming Pool Glow Swim to take place Saturday August 20, 2022. PC Andrews will be conducting cross walk safety training to Lingle students August 24th; Discussion took place on the school crosswalk and as a result two community members volunteered to assist with the crosswalk during the school year. This situation will be revisited at a future date. All is well in the department.

LVFD: S/T Lambert reported: The LVFD Street Dance will take place Saturday August 20, 2022 from 8 PM – Midnight. Food will be offered to attendees and Painter's Produce donated cabbage and onions towards the event.

POOL ITEMS: PM Hill reported: The Glow Swim will take place August 20, 2022 from 8 – 10 PM. The pool will be closed Monday August 22, 2022. The swimming pool hours of operation have been reduced due to shortage of lifeguards. The school plans to utilize the pool the second week of school.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS: C/T Reyes reported: The new office copier has been ordered and will require 9 to 12 weeks for delivery; The new maintenance pickup has been delivered to the dealership. The paperwork has been initiated.
