Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present. Mayor Siglin had Alex Hargrave introduce Logan Dailey, a new Telegram/Lingle Guide employee. Mayor Siglin called for approval of the agenda with the addition of an Executive Session. CM Cook moved to approve the agenda with the addition. CM Welte voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Siglin called for approval of the minutes of the August 5, 2020 regular council meeting. CM Welte moved to approve the minutes as presented. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

REPORTS: C Reyes reported: The final Lingle Community Center quarterly report was submitted to the Wyoming Business Council on July 15, 2020. Reports will be submitted on an annual basis beginning May 1, 2020 and continuing until May 1, 2025; the final Lingle Community Center Infrastructure Report was submitted August 14, 2020; the insurance policy for the Town has been renewed for the 2020-21 fiscal year.

ORDINANCES: FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE #348 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 5, SECTION 1-B TO INCREASE THE ELECTRIC RATES IN EFFECT FOR THE TOWN OF LINGLE.

CM Cook moved to approve the first reading of Ordinance #348. CM Welte voiced the second and the motion passed unanimously.

FIRST READING OF ORDINANCE #349 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING AND SETTING FORTH THE HOURS AND TIME LICENSED RETAIL LIQUOR DEALERS SHALL BE PERMITTED TO BE OPEN FOR BUSINESS AND THE TIME ALL PATRONS ARE TO BE REMOVED FROM THE BUSINESS PREMISES, ETC.; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 154 OF THE TOWN OF LINGLE.

CM Welte moved to approve the first reading of Ordinance #349. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS: Following discussion, CM Edwardson moved to transfer funds in the amount of \$32,630.51 from the Money Market account to the General Fund and close the Money Market account. CM Welte voiced the second and the motion passed unanimously.

Mayor Siglin advised at 5:15 P.M. that he was recessing the regular session so that Council could go into Executive Session.

Executive Session began at 5:19 P.M. and ended at 5:40 P.M. Personnel was discussed. Regular session reconvened at 5:46 P.M.

With no further action to be taken Mayor Siglin adjourned the meeting at 5:49 P.M.
