Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present. Mayor Siglin called for approval of the agenda as presented. CM Welte moved to approve the agenda. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Siglin called for approval of the minutes of the September 9, 2020 regular council meeting. CM Edwardson moved to approve the minutes as presented. CM Lambert voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS: C REYES: Reported: The coronavirus grant reimbursement was submitted to the state of Wyoming on September 14, 2020 and receipt of it has been verified; the Low Income Energy Assistance Program agreement has been submitted and the Lingle Community Center Certificate of Completion of Construction has been submitted to the Wyoming Business Council.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS: Discussion was held as to the use of the Wyoming Community Gas distribution funds in the amount of \$4,289.75. Various ideas were offered with no selection made at this time.

ORDINANCES: THIRD READING OF ORDINANCE #348 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RE-ENACTING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 5, SECTION 1-B TO INCREASE THE ELECTRIC RATES IN EFFECT FOR THE TOWN OF LINGLE.

CM Welte moved to approve the third reading of Ordinance #348. CM Cook voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

THIRD READING OF ORDINANCE #349 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING AND SETTING FORTH THE HOURS AND TIME LICENSED RETAIL LIQUOR DEALERS SHALL BE PERMITTED TO BE OPEN FOR BUSINESS AND THE TIME ALL PATRONS ARE TO BE REMOVED FROM THE BUSINESS PREMISES, ETC.; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 154 OF THE TOWN OF LINGLE.

CM Cook moved to approve the third reading of Ordinance #349. CM Lambert voiced the second and the motion carried unanimously.

COUNCIL ITEMS: Mayor Siglin advised all attendees that campaign election signs are not to be placed on Town property and will be removed if so located; Mayor Siglin urged support and continuation of the 1% sales and use tax and the Lodging Tax; he also discussed state statute Amendment "A" which updated municipal debt limit for sewer projects.

With no further action to be taken Mayor Siglin adjourned the meeting at 5:20 P.M.
