Mayor Siglin welcomed all to the meeting and thanked them for being present.

CM Newcomb moved to approve the agenda with the addition under Unfinished Business a variance request and the addition under New Business a park door estimate and radar signs. CM Greenwald voiced a second and the motion carried without dissent.

CM Newcomb moved to approve the minutes of the August 23, 2017 regular council meeting. CM Asa offered a second and the measure passed unanimously.

**LAW ENFORCEMENT:** Although PC Moen was absent, the Mayor reported she had one hundred and three (103) incidents this month.

**ADMINISTRATION:** CT Sussex announced the final grant for the Community Center has been submitted and will go before the SLIB Board in December 2017. She also reported Black Hills Energy Foundation has denied our grant for \$50k, but will be giving us \$7k for the project.

**MAINTENANCE:** ATS Ochsner reported they have completed the annual chlorinating, and water samples have been turned in. Concrete work is ongoing and almost complete for this fiscal year. They are planning on chip seal starting soon.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:** The variance for the Rick & Brandi Cook property was discussed, and council unanimously approved the variance.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Council by unanimous decision agreed to ask for volunteers to form a Lingle 100-Year Anniversary Celebration Committee for September 2018; anyone interested in being on the committee should call C/T Sussex at Town Hall. Mayor Siglin read a bid to fix the bathroom doors in the park; the bid was discussed, and the doors will be fixed. Mayor Siglin also discussed purchasing radar signs and the projector for

movie in the park night with the funds from Wyoming Community Gas; Council will re-visit purchasing these items when the funds come in May 2018.

Mayor Siglin adjourned the meeting at 5:55pm
