Mayor Foster welcomed all in attendance and thanked them for being present. Mayor Foster called for approval of the agenda. CM Lambert moved to approve the agenda as presented. POLICE ITEMS: PC Andrews reported: All is well in the Town of Lingle.

MAINTENANCE ITEMS: TS Dailey reported: The town Christmas decorations are very worn and have been repaired many times over the years. Something may need to be done for replacement; At least one water well sample may need to be taken at the landfill; Craig McComie with DEQ suggested that a pole barn be installed at the landfill. The building will be used to store refuse and some equipment; The water Consumer Confidence Report has been initiated.

LVFD ITEMS: CM Lambert reported: Five FD members will attend classes in Torrington; The coyote hunt went well; The gas line has been installed to the firehouse.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS: C/T Reyes reported: The food permit for the Community Center kitchen has been renewed; A reimbursement request for the Transfer Station has been submitted in the amount of \$22,670.77; A renewal for the town's Red Cross Licensed Training Provider has been submitted.

COUNCIL ITEMS: CM Duncan advised the council to be aware of proposed legislation reducing property taxes in the State of Wyoming by 50%. This legislation may have a negative impact on the Town of Lingle and other Wyoming municipalities.
